Resolution No. AC-04/2025/11: Resolved the following:

- a. The matter of two posts of Professor to be advertised as Assistant Professor for the Department of Business Administration and Mathematics were placed and approved with the rider that this was not a conversion but was only being advertised as such because applications had not been received for the higher posts. It was clarified that subsequent to such a step, the next advertisement due for Assistant Professor would be in fact for the post of Professor. This process was accepted in principle for similar cases from other departments.
- b. On the matter of revision of MDC courses it was felt that all four courses needed to be reviewed and the Committee for FYUGP/FYIMP might be entrusted with the responsibility of coordinating the process.
- c. Eligibility conditions for Ph.D research (for those who had completed 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8 semester bachelor's degree; or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree after a 3-year bachelor's degree; 75% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade for those seeking Ph.D admission after 4-year/8-sem bachelor's degree) were to be inserted into the GU Ph.D regulations of 2023 from the UGC Ph.D Regulations of 2022(p.9). While on the matter of Ph.D, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor urged the inclusion of SDG goals in the topics of Ph.D research wherever possible.
- d. The discontinuation of the UGC-CARE List also came up briefly but it was felt that this discussion should be held after the UGC finally clarifies its stand on the parameters to be adopted for the alternative system of assessing journals for various stages like Ph.D, guideship and recruitment.


































However it was felt that whatever the UGC notifies, GU should set its own high benchmarks for evaluating research undertaken by its scholars and faculty.

- e. The newly prepared document on Duties and Responsibilities of Deans was introduced but it was felt that this needed to be discussed in another meeting.
- f. The issue of undergraduate research was brought up by one member but the modalities for this are yet to be worked out.
- g. A request was made by one of the representatives from the colleges that after the term of a college Academic Council member expires a certificate may be given in recognition of their service.
